Today, we ask that your PA business consider participating in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania's Educational Tax Credit Program (ETC). Please know that we are not requesting a charitable contribution. You can actually divert some of your PA state business taxes from Harrisburg to help needy families pay tuition at Bishop Canevin High School. Your company would receive up to a 90% tax credit for a two-year donation and because of federal tax implications; it is virtually a dollar-for-dollar contribution.

So far, over 200 Pennsylvania business owners have participated in this Diocesan program, ten of which directed \$143,900 of their state tax dollars to provide tuition assistance at Bishop Canevin this year.

2. When notified of approval, your company then writes a check in the amount of the tax credit.

3. Finally, in a cover letter accompanying the check, designate that you specifically want Bishop Canevin High School as the recipient of the tax credit. Send check and letter to: Diocese of Pittsburgh; c/o Dr. Ron
