**MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS:**

2. Prior to final acceptance, a doctor's certificate of examination may be required.
3. A certified drug test will be required before indenturement into the Program, at the Program's expense.
4. Applicant must be a citizen of the United States (or legal alien).
5. Applicant must have a High School Diploma or GED. (Submitted with Application)
6. Applicant must have a valid driver's license for the state of residency and have dependable transportation. (Submitted with Application)
