

## **Bishop Canevin Virtual Attendance Extracurricular Waiver**

*Bishop Canevin's current policy states that students attending school virtually can only participate in their extracurricular activity if that activity is occurring virtually, or has a virtual option.*

In an effort to remain consistent, while taking into consideration the individual circumstances of each family, parents/guardians have the opportunity to issue a written request to the school administration that their student be granted a waiver to participate. Requests should include how participation in the activity supports the school mission and promotes their child's **academic, social, personal, and spiritual** growth and development. Additionally, the request should include why participating in the activity in-person is not contradictory to the reasons your family has selected virtual instruction.

While Bishop Canevin coaches/moderators understand and are operating in compliance with the school's Health and Safety plan, Bishop Canevin needs its virtual students/families to be aware of the increased exposure and risks associated with your child's participation.

Requests should be submitted to [joycem@bishopcanevin.org](mailto:joycem@bishopcanevin.org) and will be reviewed weekly by a committee of school administrators. Upon a waiver being granted the student will receive a checklist of academic expectations from the Academic Assistant Principal that must be followed by the student each day in order to participate.
