Electronic Notification Service and Weekly Parent Email

Bishop Canevin High School provides electronic notification to families in the event of a school delay or closing, or when other important information needs to be communicated to members of our school community quickly. The electronic notification service is capable of sending alerts via email, text messaging, and phone calls. You may choose one or all three of these means of notification. All charges assessed for text messages will be the responsibility of the family.

You may choose up to 3 email addresses, 3 numbers for text messaging, and 3 phone numbers to receive alerts. You may wish to include one means of contacting a caregiver or parent who may not live at the students' primary address.

Notifications of school closings and delays will continue to be posted on television on KDKA, WTAE, and WPXI.

In addition, BCHS sends out a weekly email to families titled **This Week** @ **BCHS** at the beginning of each week to keep everyone abreast of important events happening in and around our school. These weekly emails will include the words **TW@BCHS** in the subject line along with the date and will be sent to each of the email addresses you supply.
